

# GOD COMFORTS HIS PEOPLE

Lesson Text: Isaiah 40:1-5, 25-26, 29-31

“He giveth power to the faint; and to them that have no might he increaseth strength” (Isaiah 40:29).



**BIG IDEA:** God takes care of His people.



- God promised comfort to Israel after they were punished, and God wants to comfort all His people.
- God Himself will show people the way to find Him.
- God gives strength to people who have no strength.

Everyone needs help feeling better or stronger once in a while. God promised to give comfort and strength to His people when their time of punishment was over.



Jesus promised that the Holy Spirit will comfort those who follow Him.
