

GOD CREATES A WOMAN

Lesson Text: Genesis 2:18-25

"The Lord God said, It is not good that the man should be alone; I will make him an help meet for him" (Genesis 2:18).



BIG IDEA: God created woman so that man would have a helper and would not be alone.

GENESIS 2:18 And the LORD God said, It is not good that the man should be alone; I will make him an help meet for him.

- 19 And out of the ground the LORD God formed every beast of the field, and every fowl of the air; and brought them unto Adam to see what he would call them: and whatsoever Adam called every living creature, that was the name thereof.
