Bible Lesson—Philippians 1:12-26

It's hard to imagine someone being happy about being in prison. In our picture, we see the apostle Paul in prison. He had been traveling many places to tell people the good news about Jesus. Some people did not like what he was doing. They had Paul arrested.

Paul sent a letter to his friends in the city of Philippi. He told them that he was happy. Why? Paul had been telling people about Jesus while he was in prison. Now everyone in the prison and the guards now knew that Jesus came to die for their sins. If they would put their faith in Jesus, they would be able to live forever with Him in heaven.

No matter what happened to him or where he was, Paul would always tell others the good news of salvation from sin through Jesus. Paul knew if he lived, he could share the gospel. If he died, he would get to be with Jesus.
