7. **Talk About It** prompts parents/caregivers to follow up on the lesson with their children.

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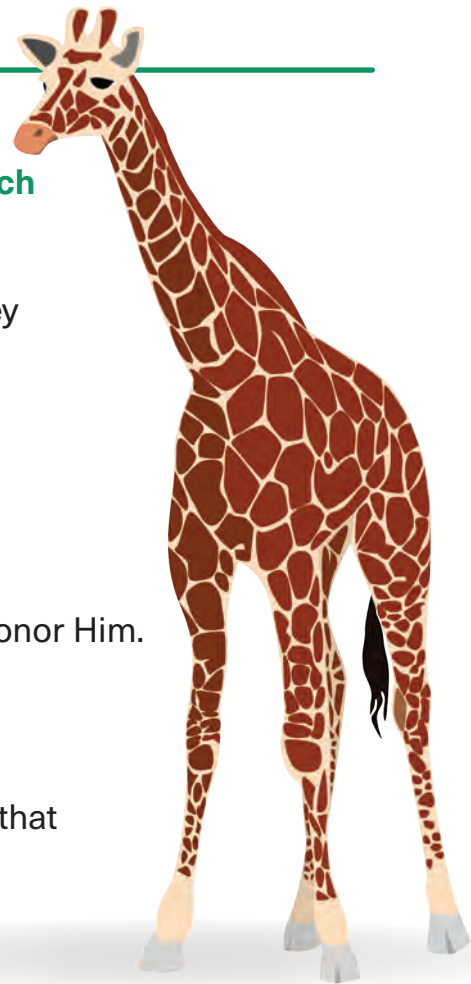
